Chapter 5**Point of View****Objective:** Learning how point of view affects a story**Activity**

In this chapter, Conrad has his first visit with Dr. Berger. The visit is told from Conrad's point of view. This is known first-person narration, in which the story is seen and told from the character's perspective. This type of narration gives the reader only one perspective. If the same story is seen from another character's perspective, it may reveal aspects of the story that the reader may not be aware of or hasn't considered. To gain a different character's perspective on an event, retell Conrad's visit from Dr. Berger's point of view. Imagine how the conversation would be interpreted by Dr. Berger based on the information provided in the text and what you know about Conrad so far. Write your observations as an entry in a private notebook that Dr. Berger keeps on his patients. Try to be as analytical as possible, as a doctor would be. We have started the entry for you with a basic outline. Be prepared to discuss your interpretation of Dr. Berger's point of view in a class discussion.
