**Chapter 6****Found Poem**

**Objectives:** Extracting information from the text  
Writing a poem

**Activity**

A “found” poem is a poem made up entirely of phrases, sentences, or quotations found in the text. Review Chapter 6, and create a found poem of your own. The poem could tell the reader something about the emotional state of one of the characters, but this is not necessary; it may be totally unrelated to the action of the story, which is one of the best parts of writing a found poem.

Your poem should be at least ten lines long. The lines do not need to rhyme, but they certainly may. You can arrange the phrases in any way you like and change the punctuation, but do not deviate from Guest's actual words. Give the poem a title, which may or may not come from the book. The following is an example taken from Chapter 1:
